## Changes to 3FP Program

### INFORMATION ABOUT PROGRAM CHANGES

In 2021, the Future Faculty Fellows Program (3FP) will be shifting to a calendar year (January to December) program. Based on feedback from recent years' cohorts, this shift will better align program outcomes with participants' career schedules and goals. Program components and outcomes will remain the same. Any graduate student meeting the 3FP application criteria is eligible to apply for the 3FP 2021 program, though students near the end of their degrees may be prioritized over students eligible for later years. Application criteria include:

**Significant teaching experience:** At least three terms of teaching experience at UGA (this semester can count towards the three required terms; holding an instructor of record position is not required).

**Enrollment:** Applicants must be enrolled full-time in a terminal degree program, and priority will be given to students within 1-2 years of graduation.

**Previous Future Faculty Fellows are not eligible.**

**Only two applicants will be considered from any single department:** Should more than two applications be received from any given department, the graduate coordinator for that department will be contacted to indicate which two applications should be considered.

Applicants should be able to demonstrate teaching passion, dedication, and innovation.
